Join our e-discussion on research performance and gender diversity

The GEDII project carried out a survey across 16 European countries, capturing 1357 individual responses distributed over 159 R&D teams. The overall design of this research project is unique in that survey responses at the team level are combined with established performance measures, i.e. bibliometric publication counts retrieved from Web of Science. This online discussion will address the main results of the survey as well as discussing alternatives to existing performance measures from a gender perspective.

About the GEDII Project

Using innovative methods for the analysis of the relationship between diversity research and performance, the GEDII team has developed new concepts and methods to examine more systematically how team-work in science is sensitive to gendered power, status and information sharing differentials. The project received funding from the European Commission within the framework of the Horizon 2020 programme and involves partners from Sweden, Germany, Spain and the UK. After nearly three years of dedicated work and ahead of our final conference held in Berlin on the 12th of July 2018, we are looking forward to sharing our findings with the wider community through three online discussions.
